# Salvation in the Tanakh

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- What's your definition of salvation?
- The Red Sea Crossing
  - Exodus 14:1-31
    - And Moses said to the people, "Do not be afraid. Stand still, ***and see the salvation of YHVH***, which He will accomplish for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall see again no more forever. YHVH will fight for you, and you shall hold your peace...Moses stretched out his hand over the sea...



# Salvation in the Tanakh

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- Anatomy of Salvation
  - Your enemy is about to annihilate you.
  - You are powerless to help or defend yourself. The odds are against you.
  - The Holy One delivers you from the hand of your enemy.
  - The Holy One destroys your enemy.
- That's Salvation!!!



# Salvation in the Tanakh

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## ➤ Hannah's Child

### ➤ I Samuel 2:1

➤ And Hannah prayed and said: "My heart rejoices in YHVH; My horn is exalted in YHVH. I smile at my enemies, Because I rejoice in Your salvation."

➤ Note the common theme of victory over one's enemy



# Salvation in the Tanakh

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## ➤ David and Goliath

### ➤ I Samuel 17:47-49a

➤ "...and all this assembly will know that ***not through sword and spear does YHVH grant salvation***; for unto YHVH is the battle, and He shall deliver you into our hands!" It happened that when the Philistine arose and moved closer towards David that David hurried and ran to the line, towards the Philistine. David stretched his hand into the sack...

➤ Note the common theme of victory over one's enemy even though the odds were against him/her



# Salvation in the Tanakh

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➤ Elazar, Son of Dodo

➤ II Samuel 23:9-10

➤ And after him was Elazar the son of Dodo, the Ahohite, one of the three mighty men with David when they defied the Philistines who were gathered there for battle, and the men of Israel had retreated. He arose and attacked the Philistines until his hand was weary, and his hand stuck to the sword. ***YHVH brought about a great salvation that day...***





# Salvation in the Tanakh

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- Elazar, Son of Dodo
  - Note the common theme of victory over one's enemy even though the odds were against him/her
  - Why is the theme of salvation so important?
    - Who will bring ultimate salvation?
    - Doesn't it make sense to look for the Messiah in the passages dealing with salvation?



# Salvation in the Tanakh

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- The Red Sea Crossing, a Picture of Salvation Through Messiah
  - Salvation will occur through one named salvation.
  - Salvation will occur through the Name **hwhy**. This salvation will be revealed (**h**) through a nail- (**w**) pierced hand (**y**).
  - ***Salvation will occur through an outstretched hand.***
  - Salvation will occur through an outstretched hand associated with wood in some manner.
  - Salvation will be not depend on the work of any man.



# Salvation in the Tanakh

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- Salvation occurs within the context of warfare!
- Salvation occurs with the outstretched hand
  - Remember Moses' outstretched hand in the Exodus defeating the enemy
  - Remember Moses' outstretched hand at the splitting of the Red Sea
  - Remember Dodo the Ahohite's outstretched hand during his battle with the Philistines
  - Remember Joshua's outstretched hand when he destroyed the city of Ai



# Salvation in the Tanakh

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- Remember David's outstretched hand in the battle against Goliath
- It's Adonai's outstretched hand that brings salvation
- It is apart from our works (remember the garden)



# Salvation in the Tanakh

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- Hebrews 2:14-15 – Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, *that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death*, that is, the devil



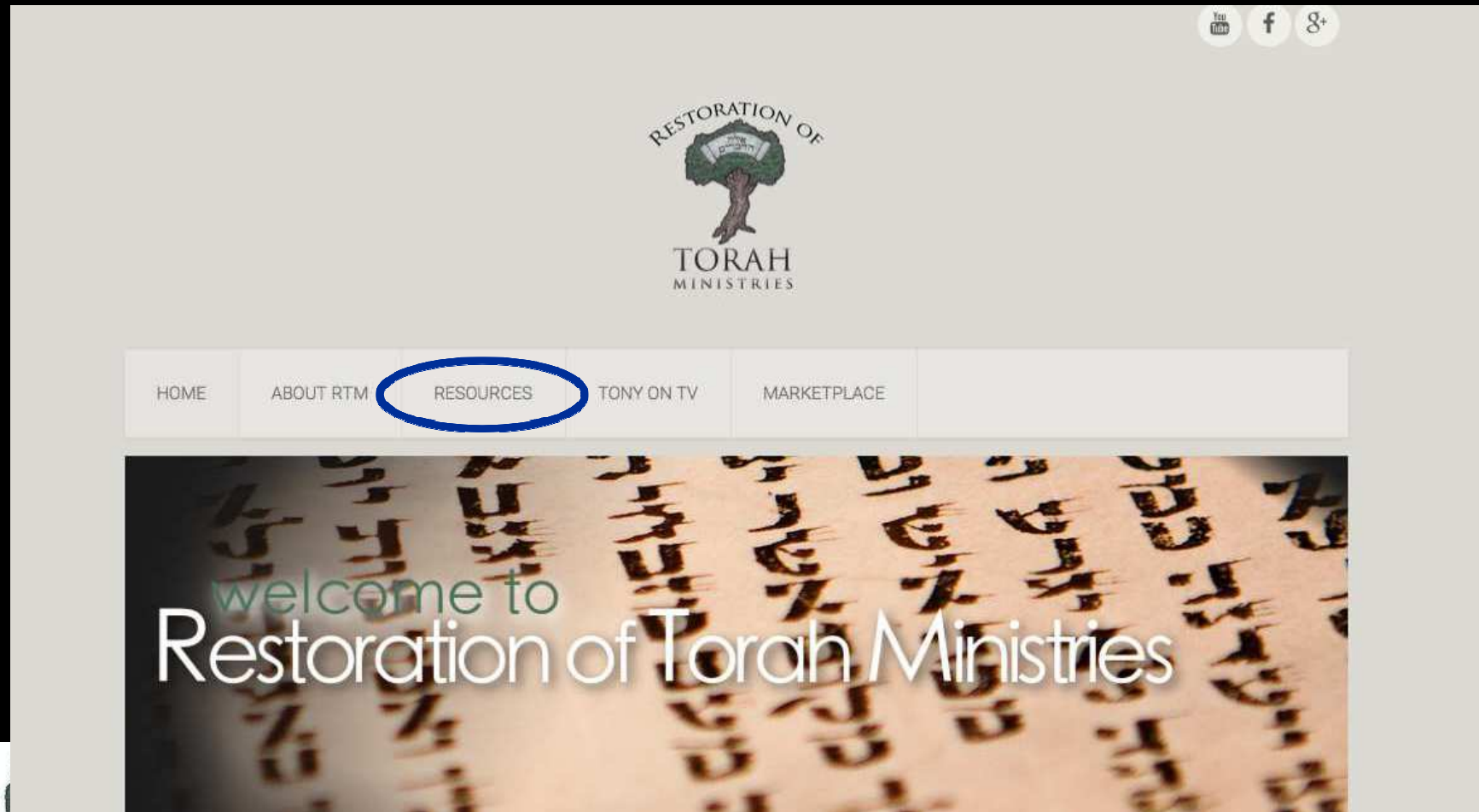
# Salvation in the Tanakh

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- Colossians 1:21-22 – And you, who once were alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now He has reconciled in the body of His flesh *through death*, to present you holy, and blameless, and above reproach in His sight



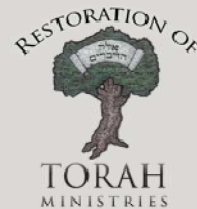
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## DE PARSHA BEGRIJPEN [GENESIS 2:4-3:15](#)

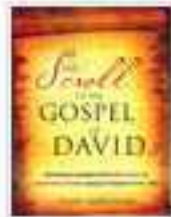
**Doelstelling** —Leren hoe 1) het hoofdthema van de Parsha te interpreteren, 2) thematische connecties met de Parsha maken en 3) leren een beter begrip van de bewuste Parsha te verwerven doorheen haar thematische connecties met andere delen van de Schrift.

I. Laten we de studie van deze week beginnen met een analyse van de achtste Parsha van de sidra (Torah gedeelte) van deze week. Lees de Parsha Stumah, [Genesis 2:4-3:15](#). We hebben reeds geleerd dat elke Parsha haar eigen unieke thema bevat. Het is ons doel het thema van deze Parsha te ontdekken. Een van de meest handige gereedschappen die we ter beschikking hebben is het bepalen van de indeling. Het is heel handig om te leren hoe de indeling te bepalen. Laten we dit doen voor onze Parsha Stumah. Denk eraan, mijn indeling is niet noodzakelijkerwijze de enige correcte indeling. Doe je best.
