


> Biblical Discipleship


> What Did Yeshua Teach About Discipleship?

John 15:5-8 – "I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing. 6 If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned. 7 If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you. 8 By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples."

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
Foundations in Discipleship

 - I John 3:24 Now he who keeps His commandments abides in Him, and He in him. And by this we know that He abides in us, by the Spirit whom He has given us.




> What Did Paul Teach About Discipleship?


Romans 12:1-2 – I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. 2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

 - Romans 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.
 - His words abide in You





> What Else Did Yeshua Teach About Discipleship?


Luke 9:23-24 – Then He said to *them* all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, *let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me*. For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will save it.


Foundations in Discipleship Connecting Yeshua and Paul's Statements Luke 9:23-24 – . . . let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me . . . Romans 12:1 – . . . present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service . . . How many thematic connections can you see between these two statements? Are these concepts taught in the Tanakh?

Foundations in Discipleship

- > Discipleship in the Tanakh
 - Genesis 22:1-19 Olah (Whole Burnt Offering)
 - Picture of the offerer giving their life in complete submission Adonai and obedience to His commandments
 - > Abraham that which is of most value to me
 - ➢ Isaac − my very life
 - Isaac as an olah carried his own wood right?
 - > The Binding of Isaac is Luke 9:23-24 in living color!

> The Olah Tamid – the Offering of Discipleship

- Olah Tamid is the offering where we present ourselves before Adonai twice each day, in the morning and "between the evenings" (typically 3:00, but anytime between once the sun begins its descent and night time)
- I see the connection between the olah tamid and obedience to Yeshua's commandments, but what about the Word of God? How does the olah tamid address the second aspect of discipleship, "His words abiding in us"?

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
Foundations in Discipleship


- Discipleship in the Tanakh
 - Exodus 25:22 And there I will meet with you, and *I will* speak with you from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubim which are on the ark of the Testimony, about everything which I will give you in commandment to the children of Israel.
 - > Adonai will speak His words (The Words of God) at the tabernacle the place we offer the olah



> Discipleship in the Tanakh

- Exodus 29:42 This shall be a continual burnt offering [olah tamid] throughout your generations at the door of the tabernacle of meeting before the Lord, where I will meet you to speak with you.
- Adonai will speak His words at the tabernacle, *the place* we offer the olah









- Exodus 29:42 The Olah Tamid Also Shows That Biblical Discipleship Consists of Two Things!
 - 1. This shall be a continual burnt offering [olah tamid]
 - 2. Where I will meet *you to speak to you* (The Words of God)










- Matthew 10:24-25a Yeshua's teaching on the master/slave and teacher/discipleship relationship shows that Biblical discipleship consists of two things:
 - 1. The slave's primary duty is to *obey his master*
 - 2. The student's primary objective is to *learn the teachings (words) of his master*

























> Discipleship in the Tanakh

- Psalm 40:6-8 Sacrifice and offering You did not desire; My ears You have opened. Burnt offering and sin offering You did not require. Then I said, "Behold, I come; In the scroll of the book it is written of me. I delight to do Your will, O my God, And Your law is within my heart."
 - "My ears you have opened" to what??? *His Word*!!!
 - "I delight to do Your will" Obedience!!!
 - > "Your law is within my heart" *His Word*!!!




> The Olah – The Sacrifice of Discipleship

- Daniel 6:10
 - Olah offering personified by Daniel's personal devotion to Adonai
 - The quintessential example of one of Adonai's servants who got the revelation and ran with it!




- Psalm 1:1-2 Blessed is the man Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, Nor stands in the path of sinners, Nor sits in the seat of the scornful; But his delight is in the law of the Lord, And in His law he meditates day and night.
 - A. Abiding in Him and He in Us (Keeping His Commandments)
 - By stating using three phrases to describe what this man *does not do*, it emphasizes what he is doing – *he's obeying Adonai's commandments*.
 - B. His words abiding in us
 - He delights and *meditates in the Word*

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


> How Did Yeshua Make Disciples

- Since Yeshua is our Master, why not follow His example of making disciples
 - Matthew 4:19 Then He said to them, "Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men."
 - Matthew 9:9 As Jesus passed on from there, He saw a man named Matthew sitting at the tax office. And He said to him, "*Follow Me*." So he arose and followed Him.




- > How Did Yeshua Make Disciples
 - He called to Himself a small group of individuals, formed intimate relationships with them, and had them follow Him wherever He went
 - As they followed Him through life's everyday circumstances He taught them (*Word abiding in us*) and gave them commandments to observe (*Abiding in Him/Keeping His commandments*)




> How Did Yeshua Make Disciples

- Yes He had big meetings where He taught the multitudes; however, that was more to draw people in than to make disciples
- Many times He would only speak to the multitudes in parables and would only reveal things to His disciples
- Many times the multitudes would initially respond favorably but would then reject Him later



- > The Starting Point
 - If being a disciple simply means to Follow Yeshua, then making disciples simply means to help each other Follow Yeshua!
 - This should be done as Yeshua did it . . .



- > We Need to Make Disciples as Yeshua Made Disciples
 - As they followed Him through life's everyday circumstances He taught them (*Word abiding in us*) and gave them commandments to observe (*Abiding in Him/Keeping His commandments*)

THEREFORE

We need to help each other know, understand, and believe Yeshua's teachings (*Word abiding in us*) and put them into practice (*Abiding in Him/Keeping His commandments*)

> This is Done One Intimate Conversation at a Time


- > We already have intimate relationships with each other
- > We already spend intimate time with each other
- > We already talk to each other regularly
- The key to discipleship is to seize the opportunity to transform our day to day conversations with each other from just mundane conversations to conversations that have the goal of helping each other Follow Yeshua

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Making Disciples of Yeshua


> This is Done One Intimate Conversation at a Time

- What would happen if every time you had a conversation with an intimate friend you asked one of the following questions at some time during the discussion:
 - > What's Adonai doing in your life?
 - > Where is Yeshua leading you today in this situation?
 - > How's your pursuit of Yeshua going?
 - > How are you progressing in getting the Word into you?
 - > Are there any commandments Adonai is dealing with you about?
 - How are you obeying such and such a command?




> This is Done One Intimate Conversation at a Time

- What would happen if you took these messages to heart and began to partner with your intimate friends and determined that you were going to help each other put the teachings into practice?
- What would happen if you and your intimate friends covenanted with each other that you would commit yourselves to helping each other follow Yeshua such that when you talk to each other you expect for the other person to engage you in these types of conversations?



> This is Done One Intimate Conversation at a Time

- What would happen if you made it a point to be an encourager in all of your conversations with your intimate friends?
- What would happen if you asked Adonai to give you wisdom for sharing encouragement from Scripture about a friends struggle?
- What would happen if you intimate friends covenanted to pray for the difficult aspects of each others' lives?
- > What would happen if you began to share areas of weakness with an intimate friend so that you can mutually encourage one another with prayer and love?



> This is Done One Intimate Conversation at a Time

What would happen if you and your intimate group of friends covenanted to begin helping each other study the word by setting goals for reading, meditating, etc.? And what would happen if you submitted yourselves to be accountable to each other to complete the task at hand?
